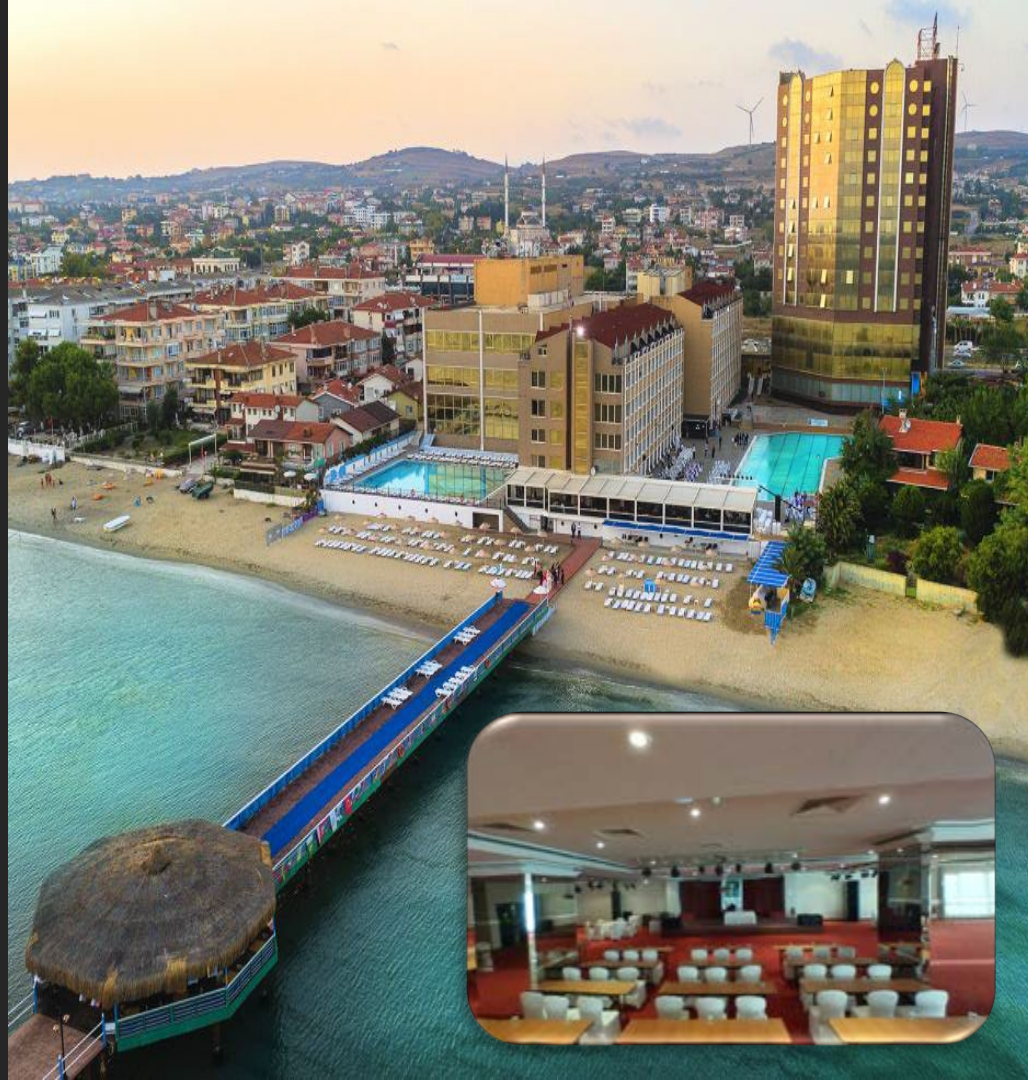

Competition events

Group 1 Traditional Taijiquan

Traditional Taijiquan; Chen, Yang, Sun, Wu, Wu, Wu (hao), Li, Wudang, Zhaobao and other traditional Taijiquan styles, Taiji qixie (taiji weapons), Taiji duilian (team competitions) and Taijituishou (push hands) competitions.

The time limit is 4 minutes for quanshu (hand forms), qixie (weapons) and 1 minute for duilian (team competition),

NOTE: 24, 48, 88, 42 and other single modern styles are not allowed. Modern Taiji duilian style is also allowed provided that it is in accordance with the original.

Group 2 Traditional Bagua, Xingyi, Bajiquan

Traditional Bagua, Xingyi, Bajiquan styles are divided into 3 competitions: quanshu (hand forms), qixie (weapons) and duilian (team competition). The duration is 2 minutes for hand forms and weapons routines and 1 minute for Duilian.

Group 3 Traditional Nanquan

Traditional Guandong, Fujian, Sichuan etc. Nanquan schools (Hong, li, mo, cailifo vs. Yongchun (wing chun) imitations. Duration is 2 minutes for hand forms and armed routines and 1 minute for Duilian.

Group 4 Traditional Shaolinquan

Traditional Songshan is divided into 3 competitions, Shaolinquan quanshu (empty hand), qixie (weapons) and duilian (team competition). The duration is 2 minutes for hand forms and weapons routines and 1 minute for Duilian.

Group 5 Imitation Styles

Imitation styles such as Houquan, Yinzhuaquan, Zuiquan, Tanglangquan, Ditangquan, Zonghequan, Minghequan, Heihuquan etc. are divided into 3 competitions: quanshu (hand forms), qixie (weapons) and duilian (team competition). The duration is 2 minutes for hand forms and weapons routines and 1 minute for Duilian.

Group 6 Traditional Tongbei, Fanzi, Chuojiao, Pigua Styles

Traditional Tongbei, Fanzi, Chuojiao, Pigua Styles are divided into 3 competitions: quanshu (empty hand), qixie (weapons) and duilian (team competition). The duration is 2 minutes for hand forms and weapons routines and 1 minute for Duilian.

Group 7 Traditional Yongchun (Wing chun)

Traditional Yongchun Quanshu movements (biu ji) and (chum hui), combat movements (liu disn ban gun), (hudie shuang dao) and wooden stick movements are allowed. The time for hand forms and gun routines is 2 minutes and 1 minute for Duilian.

Group 8 Other traditional styles

All other hand and armed styles: chaquan, huaquan, baoquan, baimei, liuhequan, gongliquan, yuejiaquan, wudangquan, (except wudang, taijiquan, xingyiquan and baguaquan which belong to the upper category) Traditional weapons (single, double, flexible) not belonging to the previous category Competitions in these techniques are allowed. It is divided into 3 competitions as empty hand, armed and duilian. The duration is 2 minutes in hand forms and armed routines and 1 minute in Duilian.

SANDA COMPETITION METHODS

1. The competition will be Individual Competition.
2. The single knockout system will be adopted. If the number of competitors is three (3) or less, a single round-robin method will be adopted.
3. Following arrival and registration, the athletes will go through the initial weighing in and drawing lots formalities as stipulated in the schedule.
4. All Sanda athletes will be required to weigh-in daily during the competition.

SANDA COSTUMES & EQUIPMENT

All competitors shall wear WKFE approved clothing and protective gear. WKFE approved clothing for men includes sanda shorts and vest, and for women includes sanda shorts and t-shirt. The shorts and vest will be of the same color, namely red or blue.

Competitors are required to provide their own clothing and this should include one (1) set in red and one (1) set in blue.

Protective gear is separated into two colors, namely red and blue. Protective gear includes headgear, gloves, chest protector. Competitors are required to provide their own gum guard, groin cups and hand wraps. The groin cups must be worn under the trunks.

The length for hand wraps shall be between 3.5m and 4.5m in total. Provided by the O.C.: Sanda gloves, head-guards and body armour (optionally, participants may provide their own if it conforms to requirements. The WKFE TC shall have the final say on acceptability)

LIGHT SANDA

Protective gear and costume is as in Sanda and also includes shin and insteps guards.

MEMBERSHIP

Only those member federations, which have paid their Wushu Kungfu Federation of Europe (WKFE) annual membership fees for 2023, will be permitted to participate in the Championships.

The federation applying to join WKFE may be invited to take part in the Championships after their applications have been accepted by the WKFE the Eligibility of the Athlete.

All athletes and judges (except independent judges invited by the WKFE) must be nationals (or legal residents with a valid long-term residence permit) of the country they represent or nationals of the country in which an WKFE recognized wushu organization is registered.

Those Athletes who have dual citizenship can only represent one (1) country/ region in the championships.



PARTICIPATION

METHOD

- Each team may at most enter three (3) athletes per same event in Taolu and two (2) athletes per same weight category in Tuishou.
- In Sanda and Light Sanda: Each athlete may enter at maximum one (1) weight division for either Sanda OR to one (1) weight division for Light Sanda.
- In Taolu: Each athlete may at most enter four (4) competition events: one (1) bare-handed routine + two (2) weapon routines + one (1) duilian or two (2) bare-handed routines + one (1) weapon routine + one (1) duilian
- Each athlete may enter 2 disciplines (Taolu + Tuishou or Taolu+ Light Sanda or Light Sanda+Tuishou) except combination of Light Sanda and Sanda where he/she must choose one of those
- If there are less than 3 athletes in Taolu per category/event, WKFE reserves the right to group accordingly other divisions.

All participating countries will be able to participate in Sanda, Light Sanda with one (1) athlete and in Tuishou with two(2) athlete in each weight and in Taolu with three (3) athletes in each routine. Turkey will be able to participate with two (2) athletes in each weight in Light Sanda.

COMPETITION METHODS

Competition Rules and Judging Methods

Traditional Taolu: Unless otherwise stated within these regulations, the competition will be conducted in accordance with the 2019 IWUF “Traditional Wushu Competition Rules and Judging Methods (Trial)”. The Rules and Methods may be interpreted solely at the discretion of the IWUF. In the event of language discrepancies in the “Rules” and “Methods”, the English version shall prevail

COMPETITION METHODS

Allowed forms and categorizing of forms

There will not be any specific forms or movements forbidden or disallowed on the competition. The performances will be judged based on the content and the skill of the performer according to the rules.

Event time limits

- Hand and weapon routines (except Taijiquan-type Events) from 1 minutes – 1 minutes 20 seconds
- Taijiquan-type Events – 3-4 minutes
- Duilian routine – 50 seconds

Music

There will be no accompanying music allowed.



COSTUME & EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

Costume Requirements for Competition

All athletes shall wear wushu competition uniforms in compliance with the rules during all events. All athletes must provide their own uniform.

Sanda - Light Sanda Equipment The equipment for Sanda and Light Sanda (Gloves, Head and Chest protector will be provided by the Organizer .

Equipment Requirements

All weapons must conform to the requirements as stipulated in the Rules. All athletes must provide their own weaponry.

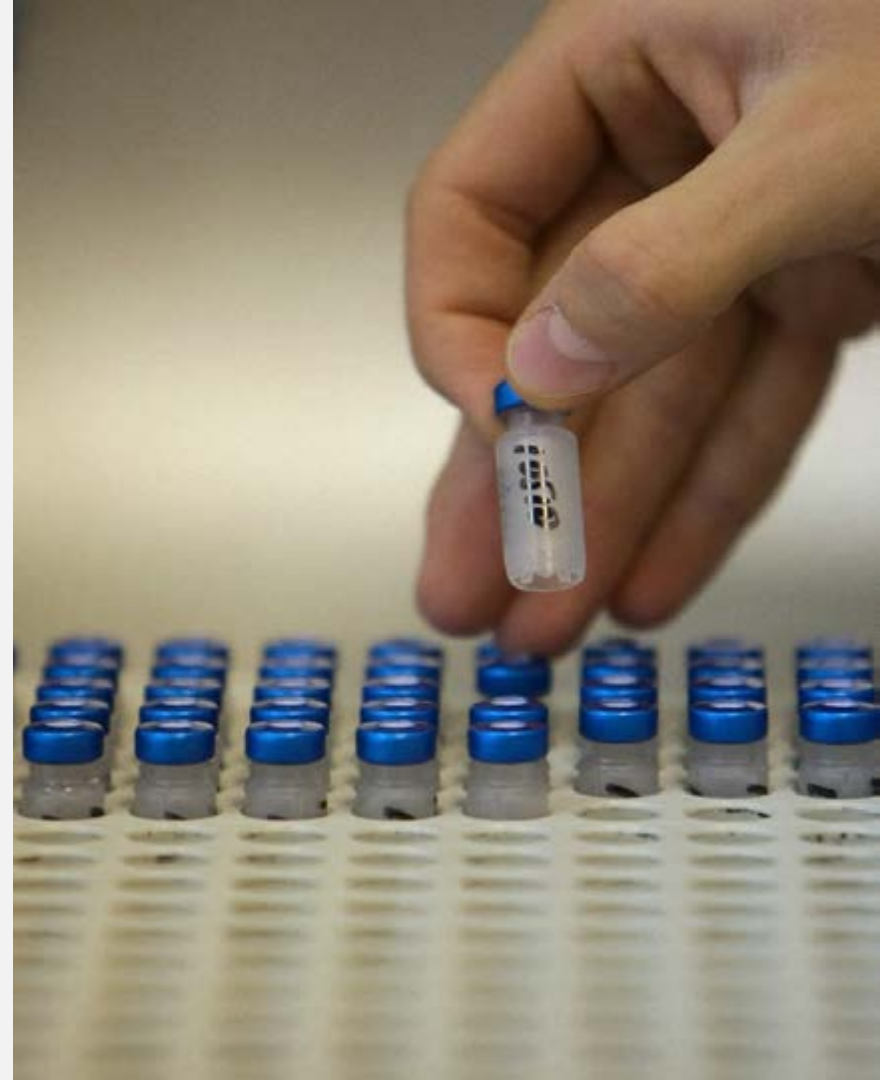


Doping Control

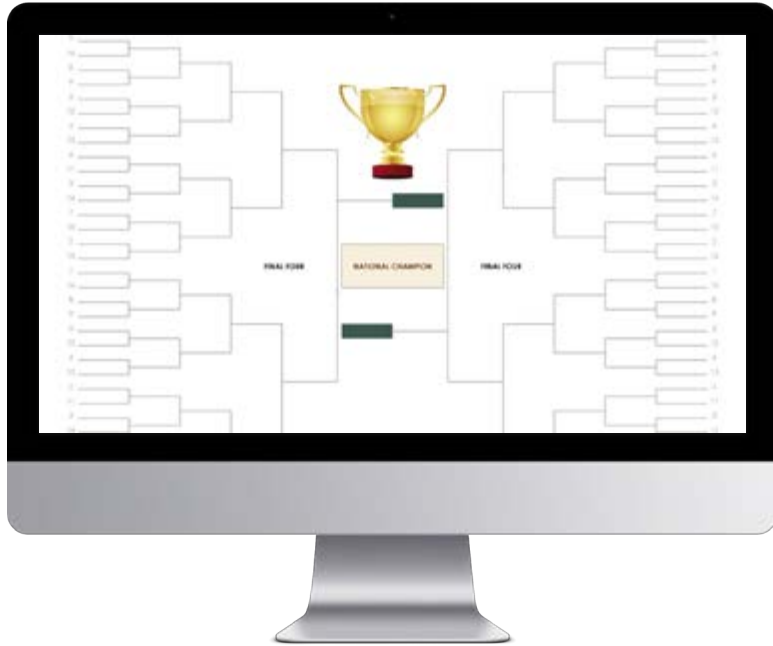
